SUBJECT: Foreign Decorations/Awards

1. Under the provisions of Section 7342, Title 5, US Code, and Chapter 7, AR 672-5-1,
 is authorized to accept and wear the:

SACRED MILITARY CONSTANTINIAN ORDER OF SAINT GEORGE

2. The order of precedence for U.S. Decorations is governed by Chapter 28, AR 670-1. Foreign military decorations are worn in the order of their receipt after all U.S. decorations, the Good Conduct Medal, campaign and service medals, and service and training ribbons. However, if the ribbon does not conform to standard size U.S. ribbons, it may not be worn on the uniform blouse although the full size foreign decorations may be worn on the dress uniform.
